


# Don't tell me what to do!'

One of the things I've always struggled with - since I was a teenager - is being told what to do by my parents! I still remember being in my early teens, standing in the kitchen with my mother, as she tried to teach me how to bake and clean. I'd get really irritated by her instructions—even though, deep down, I knew I needed to learn how to do things properly.

But the truth is, I've always preferred learning by experience—doing things my own way. Even if my way wasn't always the quickest or the best, I knew I had done it my way!

I wonder if that's a little like how Peter felt in our Gospel reading today. He and his companions were experienced fishermen. Fishing was their livelihood. They knew the water, the weather, and the best methods to bring in a good catch. And yet - they'd worked all night and caught absolutely nothing. So, when a stranger comes along (they didn't yet know it was Jesus!) and tells them to put their nets out again... how must that have felt? Frustrating? Confusing? Maybe they were so exhausted and desperate that they just thought, "Why not?" Of course - everything changed. They listened. They acted...and the rest, as they say, is history. Age and experience have taught me that real wisdom often comes when we're willing to listen - to advice, to other perspectives, and especially to God's prompting. It's not always easy. Doing what Jesus asks can be uncomfortable and even frightening at times as it often takes us out of our comfort zone. But time and again, we find that it is in those moments of trust and obedience that God shows up, so much more 'than we could ever ask or imagine'.
